



CROSS-CULTURAL EVANGELISM TOOL KIT

INTERACTIVE STUDY GUIDE FOR REACHING MUSLIMS

This worksheet is available to you individually or in a group setting. Jot down answers to questions and generate group activities as the Holy Spirit directs you.

Chapter 1

What are some key ways to establish lasting relationships with Muslims?

Name a few things you can learn and do to help you integrate into a Muslim society.

Do you have a faith testimony you feel would make an impact on a Muslim? If so, share it with your group. Provide feedback to one another.

Chapter 2

Can you tell a story using Muslim “heart language” phrases? Choose a story from the Bible and practice telling it to your group. If you are familiar with stories (or bridging phrases) from the Quran, see if you can tie in your story with a story from the Quran.

Discuss some ways you can be respectful to Muslims when speaking to them about their faith and culture.

Chapter 3

Turn to the person next to you and practice sharing the Gospel story using one of the “Kingdom Circles” methods. As you practice with one another, ask questions that Muslims might ask. Practice giving answers using phrases to which Muslims will relate.

Chapter 4

Knowing Bible stories in relation to the stories of the Quran takes time and much research. If you are familiar with any of the teachings of the Quran, think of a story of blood sacrifice you could share with a Muslim in relation to a story from the Bible. Share with your group.

If no one from your group is familiar with the teachings of the Quran, discuss ways you can build your understanding of good bridges from phrases in the Quran to Biblical truths.

Chapter 5

Muslims love to hear stories, especially about visions and dreams. Do you have a vision, dream, or story you can share which could relate to your Muslim friend.

Chapter 6

Make of list of tools you can take with you when visiting villages or places where you can meet Muslim people.
